What to do.

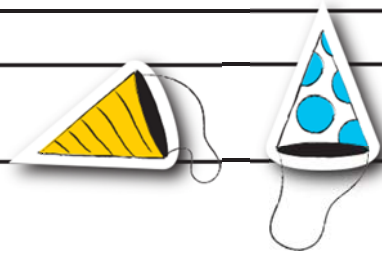
Find out how much money you have to spend on your party – this is your total budget. Then calculate the cost of each party item and subtract them from your total budget to see how much you can afford.
